To achieve this, we need to recycle.

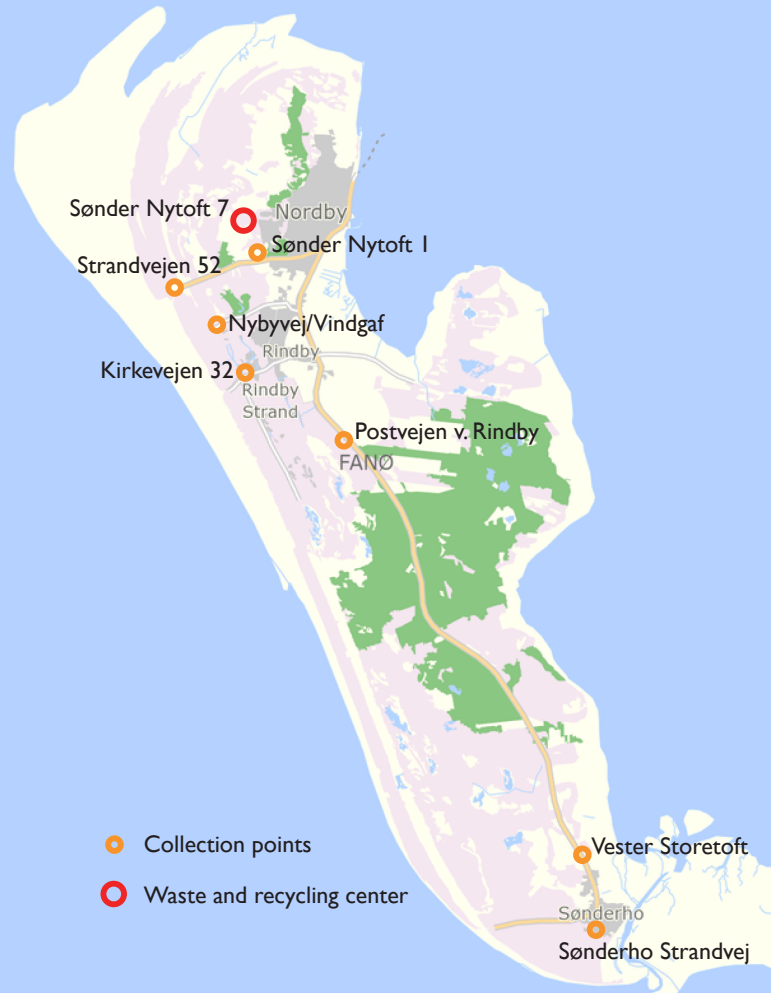
We are on the right track, but we can do even better.

# How to recycle on Fanø

The ten types of waste and recyclables are marked with Denmark's national pictogram system.

Look for the pictograms at your local collection point or at the waste and recycling center (see the map on the back of this pamphlet).

Thank you for helping make our island greener.

Recycling makes a difference - even when on vacation!




**FOOD WASTE**

Food scraps, expired food, coffee grounds and filters, cut flowers, paper towels with oils etc.




**CARDBOARD**

Cardboard boxes, shoe boxes, egg trays and other clean, dry cardboard packaging.




**PAPER**

News papers, magazines, receipts, envelopes with or without panes, paper bags etc.




**PLASTIC**

Plastic trays, containers and lids, plastic bags, cling film, plastic toys without electronics etc.




**METAL**

Food tins and lids, tea light cups, pots, pans, cutlery, beer and soda cans without deposit-labels ("pant" in Danish) etc. Please empty and scrape packaging.




**GLASS**

Glass and glass bottles without deposit-labels ("pant" in Danish) in all colors, vitamin glasses etc. Please empty and scrape glass containers.




**HAZARDOUS WASTE**

Batteries can be turned in at the collection points. Hazardous waste like paint, oil, light bulbs, nail polish etc. is collected at the waste and recycling center.




**RESIDUAL WASTE**

Pizza boxes, single-use masks, cigaret buds, ashes (in a sealed bag) etc. All waste that does not belong in one of the above mentioned recycling categories.




**TEXTILES**

Clothes and textiles with holes or stains, that are unusable. Textiles need to be dry to prevent mold and without paint, oils or rubbing alcohol etc.




**FOOD AND BEVERAGE CARTONS**

Cartons for milk, yoghurt, juice, tomatoes or beans etc. Please empty and scrape the cartons.
